## Topic: Local Study

### Literacy

We will be studying stories and short novels that raise issues e.g. bullying, injustice and bereavement. We will study poetry in different forms. Adverts, circulars and flyers will form the basis of our non fiction reading.



### Numeracy

We shall be developing our strategies for mental addition and subtraction. We will continue to work on multiplication and division, learning tables and also finding the remainders after division. We shall learn to recognize equivalent fractions, classify polygons by using given criteria and understand the properties of 3D shapes. We will know and use units of measurements.

### ICT

We will be learning how to use a data handling package to produce a variety of different graphs. We will use the information to support and argument.



### Science

We shall be studying habitats and organisms that live in them. We shall sort living things and investigate food chains. After half term we will be constructing circuits and finding out about conductors and insulators.

### RE

The Eagles will be thinking about the choices they have to make in life. They will be considering their future, and what part religion may play in it.

### DT

We will be investigating, designing & making packaging with a specific purpose.



### Geography & History

In geography and history we shall be exploring our local area & finding out about land use and buildings in Flitton & Greenfield. We will be using maps of our area & researching how the villages have changed over the years.

### P.E.

We will be doing lots of PE this term. We will be learning skills for tennis and kwik cricket and practising athletics for sports day. After half term we will go to Pulloxhill to swim. We will also be learning dances.



### PSHCE

Will involve discussions about having a healthy body. This will include healthy eating, exercise, germs and viruses & caring for teeth.

### Music

During music this term we will learning about how musical elements can be used together to compose descriptive music; combine sounds with movement and narrative. We will also sing and play a range of singing games; describing their musical characteristics.

### Art

Our art work will explore ideas about dreams, collecting visual and other information from different viewpoints. We will develop dream scenes using printing techniques.
